

How to arrive to CIOR Summer Congress Helsinki

Arriving from Helsinki International Airport to downtown Helsinki

Taxi pricing in Finland is only reliable if specifically agreed upon beforehand. Taxi from Helsinki airport to the city centre is anywhere from 35-50 euros.

We recommend using the train to transit between the airport and the central railway station in the heart of the city:

1. Make your way to the train station under the airport terminal. It is a short walk from the arrivals terminal. There is only one train station, so follow the signs in the terminal after baggage claim.
2. Buy the ticket at the platform (HSL app or ticket machine on the platform). The ticket for zones ABC costs 4,10 euros.
3. Board the I or P train (whichever is first). Both trains go to Helsinki city centre (last station) Helsinki Railway station.

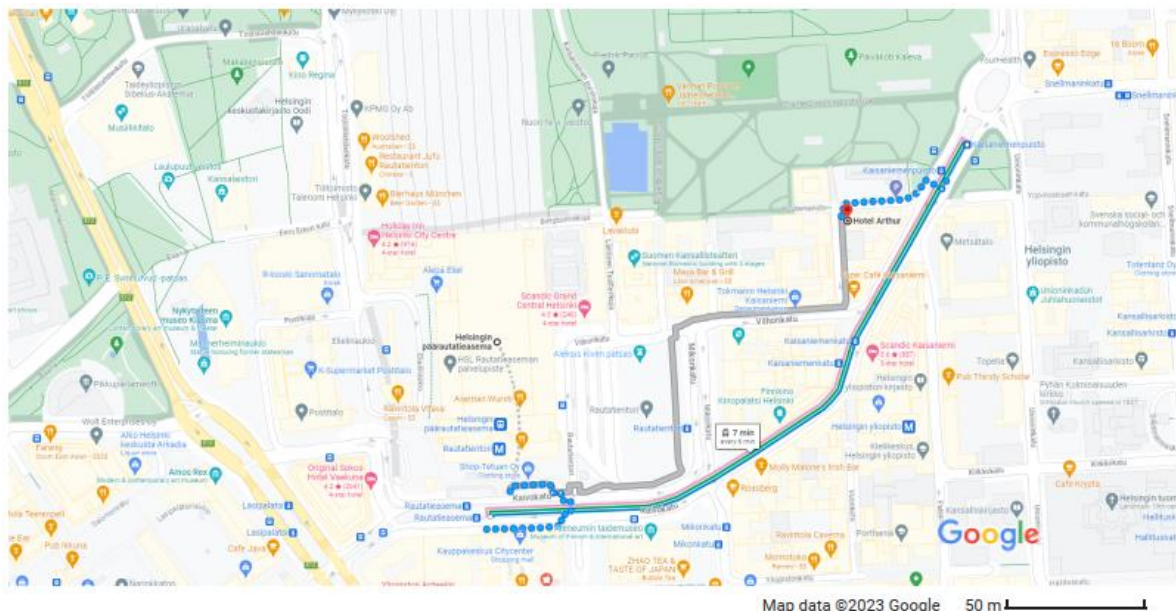
The same HSL ABC ticket can be used for later connections metro, busses and trams for 90 minutes from purchase.

Please note that if you plan to buy a ticket valid for several days, you only need an AB ticket for your journeys in downtown Helsinki. You may consider purchasing tickets valid for more than 48 hours in downtown Helsinki after arriving at your hotel since the ABC zones ticket is more expensive than the AB zones ticket.

Last leg from Helsinki Railway Station to the hotels:

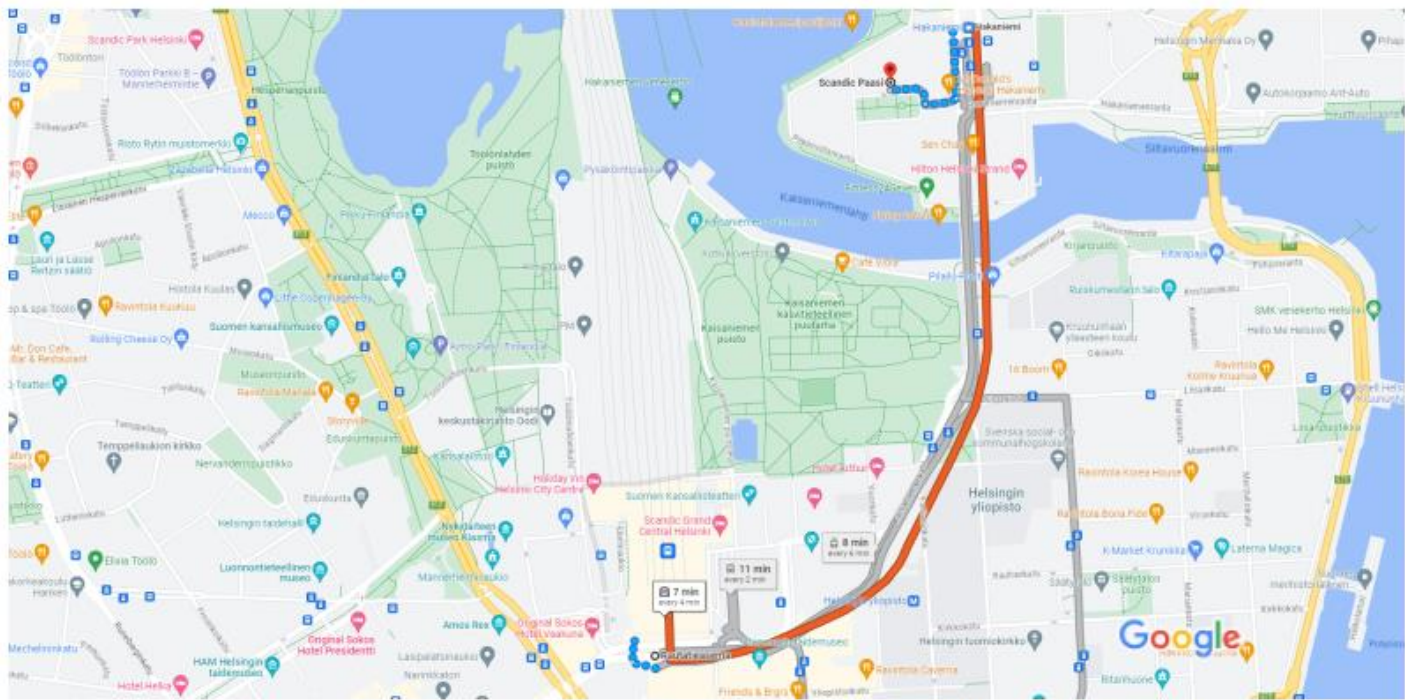
Hotel Arthur

1. Walk to the hotel (300m) from the Helsinki Railway Station. Exit the Railway station Rautatientori direction (Vilhonkatu) as shown in the map. or
2. Use the tram; the stop is in front of the main exit on Kaivokatu Street. You can use lines 3 (Meilahti), 6 (Arabia via Sörnänen) or 9 (Linjat). Leave the tram at Kaisaniemi (2nd stop on your journey).



Hotel Scandic Paasi and Hotel Hilton Helsinki Strand

1. From the Helsinki railway station, head to the underground metro station. The entrance to the metro is next to the main exit, towards Kaivokatu Street. All the lines operate from the same platform. Choose the metro M1 or M2 to Vuosaari or Mellunmäki direction via Itäkeskus.
2. Leave the metro at the Hakaniemi (2nd stop on your journey), just after Helsinki University stop.
3. Walk to the hotel (under 100m).
